

Vinyl Records Now the Fastest Growing Music Segment

Celebrating the Record Renaissance on Vinyl Record Day, August 12, 2016

Richmond, BC, August 10, 2016 – Despite an explosion in digital album sales, vinyl records are now the fastest growing music segment. For the first six months of 2016 alone, Vinyl LP sales were up 39 per cent in Canada over last year, according to [Nielsen Canada's 2016 Mid-Year Music Canada Report](#).
