APRIL 1, 2016– RICHMOND, B.C. – This Autism Awareness Month London Drugs will partner again with Puzzled Jewelry to further raise awareness for Autism Spectrum Disorder. From April 1st to 30th, 2016, Puzzled Jewelry sterling silver necklace will be available at select London Drugs locations.

The 925 sterling silver puzzle necklace created by three mothers will support the new Autism Centre of Excellence. Patricia James, Keri Kennett and Debbie Siu joined together following autism diagnoses that affected each of their little boys. Each year Puzzled Jewelry designs a unique puzzle piece item to build awareness of Autism.



Autism Spectrum Disorder is a developmental condition that impacts typical brain growth. As a spectrum disorder, ASD has a wide variation in how it affects each person. Common characteristics include difficulties with communication and social interactions, repetitive interests and activities, and stereotypic motor behaviours.

At a cost of \$25.00 plus tax, the proceeds from the necklace will go towards the construction of the new Autism Centre. Slated to open in the Summer of 2016, the Pacific Autism Family Centre (PAFC) core purpose is to become a knowledge centre while addressing the support and services required. The Centre will be the hub for research, and collaboration, providing individuals and their families with resources for their lifespan and will be the first of its kind in North America. The Centre of knowledge and innovation will involve the development of physical “hub and spoke/satellite” centres located in communities across the province, in collaboration with local community partners.
