## **Santa for Seniors Holiday Donation Drive Supports Grande Prairie Seniors**

*Popular Holiday Campaign Expands to Grande Prairie Region Helping Even More Seniors in Northern Alberta*

Like Hannah and Anne, the wish lists for each senior are completely personalized to items they select for their wish list.

"It's so humbling to read the wish lists that come through from the seniors, as most the items are truly modest, and some people only put one simple item on their lists," says **Shelly Abrey, London Drugs Store Manager**. "On occasion, we see a request for a Blu-ray DVD player, but for the most part people are asking for slippers, razors, travel mugs and treats like cookies or crackers. It's such simple things and it really puts things into perspective during the holiday season."
